

Green Grass with Less Blue

Forget Odd or Even Watering Days



Half of Twin Cities residents run their irrigation systems every other day, but your lawn doesn't need it! Remember, it rains, too. An irrigation system with a SMART controller can figure it out for you. It automatically adjusts to weather and soil moisture content.

Rain + Watering = 1" Per Week

Watering too much encourages disease to spread and keeps grass roots short, and unable to handle drought. Wet soil to 6-8" depth (over several sprinklings) and wait a week to water again.
